More than 400 participants from 29 countries

Brazil has become the world capital of supply sector at the end of September, with the realization of the 29th Annual Congress of the World Union of Wholesale Markets.

The initiative, promoted by the WUWM and organized by the Brazilian Association of Wholesale Markets (Abracen), discussed the effects of climate change on agricultural production and the situation of supply sector.

More than 400 people from 29 countries attended the <u>event</u>. The final letter presented a very worrying situation, with recommendations to the government and society on the supply of food, each day more compromised by climate change. The program included, among other things, <u>one conference and four thematic debates</u>.
